

HONR4000 Honours Project Guidelines for Undergraduate Honours Project Symposium – Oral Presentation

- 1. Each presenter should wear formal attire for the oral presentation.
- 2. Prior registration is required. Presenters should check-in at the registration desk before their start of presentation. Detail of the registration schedule and venue will be announced through the HC General Office.
- 3. Each presenter should arrive at the presentation venue at least 15 minutes before the start of their assigned session.
- 4. Each oral presentation will last for 25 minutes, of which 20 minutes for research project presentation and 5 minutes for Question-and-Answer session.
- 5. Each oral presentation must, and will, begin and end on time. Presenter should be responsible for the consequences of his/her late arrival.
- 6. All oral presentations should be conducted in English. Chinese is acceptable only with the prior approval from his/her project supervisor(s).
- 7. Each presenter should prepare his/her PowerPoint file for the oral presentation.
- 8. Laptops used for the Symposium are PC-based. All presentation must be PC-compatible. Mac compatible equipment will not be provided.
- 9. Any pieces of equipment can fail. Please be prepared to present, even if the equipment fails.
- 10. Presenter is encouraged to review the presentation at least 24 hours before the scheduled presentation.
- 11. Presenter is highly encouraged to stay to support his/her peers after his/her own presentation.
